RaboSaver makes it easy to move money around your accounts while still receiving a great rate.*

- Interest calculated daily, paid monthly
- No account fees or minimum balance
- Unlimited deposits and withdrawals



NoticeSaver

Earn a variable rate for savings that you don't need immediate access to and that you can top up at any time.*

- Add to your balance and make withdrawals at any time (60 days' notice required)
- Available for all account types



PremiumSaver

Be rewarded with premium interest when you are actively saving every month.*

- Increase your balance by \$50 per month, not including interest, to earn the premium interest rate
- Premium rate available on balances up to \$100,000, balances above this up to \$5 million will earn the RaboSaver rate
- No account fees



Term Deposit

Start with as little as \$1,000 and choose a term that suits you from 1 month up to 5 years.*

- Fixed interest rate and term
- Minimum Term Deposit of \$1,000

Applying for an account

To be eligible to open an account, you will need to be:

- A New Zealand tax resident and reside in New Zealand
- 12 years or older to be eligible to open a personal account

You will need to have:

- A New Zealand bank account in your name with another financial institution
- A valid driver license or passport
- Your mobile phone by your side
- Your IRD Number if you have it handy (you can provide this later)
- A smart device (mobile or tablet) is required to download our mobile app to access and operate your account

The application process

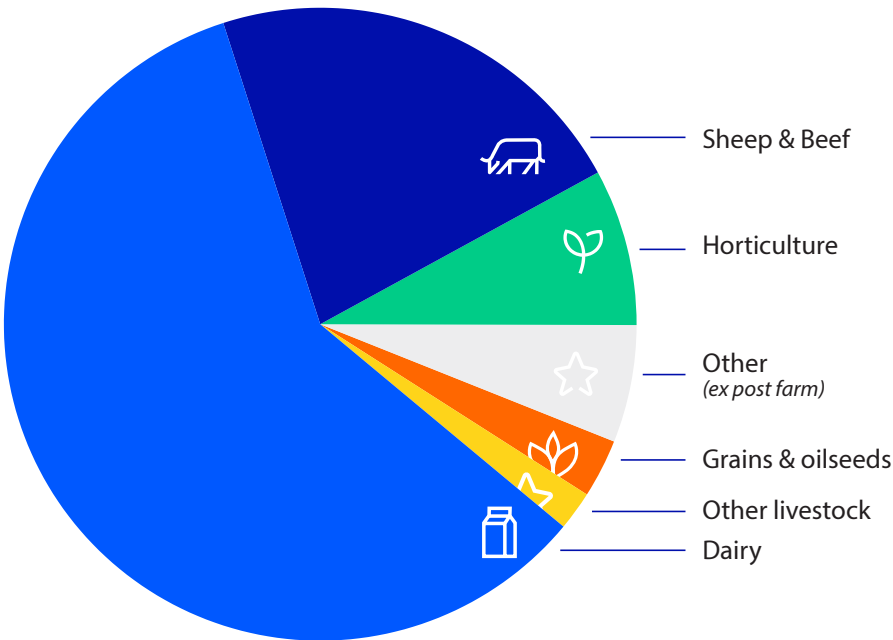
To open an account with us, visit our website rabobank.co.nz, hover over the 'Apply for Savings Accounts' button and click 'New Application' to complete the online application form.

- 1 Your application will be reviewed to make sure we have everything we need
- 2 We will be in contact within 2 business days about your application and let you know if we require any additional information
- 3 Once your account is opened we will send you a welcome email with information on how to access your account

Can I open an account at a Rabobank regional office?

Our staff located in our regional Rabobank offices can assist with identity document verification to support the account opening process but are unable to assist with any other day-to-day account enquires for our Online Savings service.



What is a nominated account?

A nominated account is an external bank account held in the same name as your Rabobank Online Savings account. You need to provide details of this account on your application form. It is used for transferring money to and from your Rabobank Online Savings account.



How is my account protected?

The security of your bank account and transactions is our top priority. To ensure safe and secure access, our website and mobile app require multi-factor authentication. This added layer of protection helps you bank with confidence and peace of mind.



Can I add new savings products to my account?

When logged in to your Internet Banking or mobile app you can open new savings accounts and term deposits in the '[Accounts](#)' tab. Please note; this is to add new products along with your existing account not for a new account holder.



What is Secure Code?

The Secure Code generator on the Rabobank Online Savings NZ app provides strong security and added convenience for our customers when accessing Internet Banking and authorising transactions.
